The Workforce Engineers Program aims at **driving productivity** through innovative workforce management and **creating a diverse workforce profile**. The program has a number of components including:

- **Three options for workshops** aimed at an introductory, basic and intermediate level understanding and implementation of good workforce management practices – you can choose to attend the sessions that meet your requirements;
- **One-on-one coaching and mentoring** sessions (2 hours/participant) and practical, easy to use workforce planning, development and management tools – where we can get into the specifics for your firm; and

Workforce BluePrint will write up five participating firms as case studies and will document two good practice demonstration firms. The program will run from August – November 2010.
